Hi Mark, here is an updated agreement for you reflecting what we discussed this afternoon. I've added the 4 cameras on [REDACTED] and the 4 cameras covering [REDACTED]

This makes the total at 49 cameras.

I've also attached two versions of the maps so you can compare them, and I added the number of cameras at each pin. One version shows the downtown cameras as we've been discussing them. The second version show what it would look like with the downtown cameras being a little more spread out.

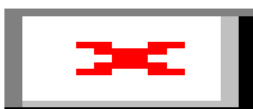
