470.8 ALPR DATA DETECTION

It is the responsibility of the Sheriff's Office to ensure that when ALPR detection is conducted of ALPR detection. The Department will audit a sample of the data for a six-month period to verify proper use in accordance with policy. The audit will select at least 10 detection browser history entries from the preceding six-month period and compare them to the data in policy section 470.5(e). The audit will result in a memorandum to the Chief of Police that such errors can be corrected and that associated documentation shall
