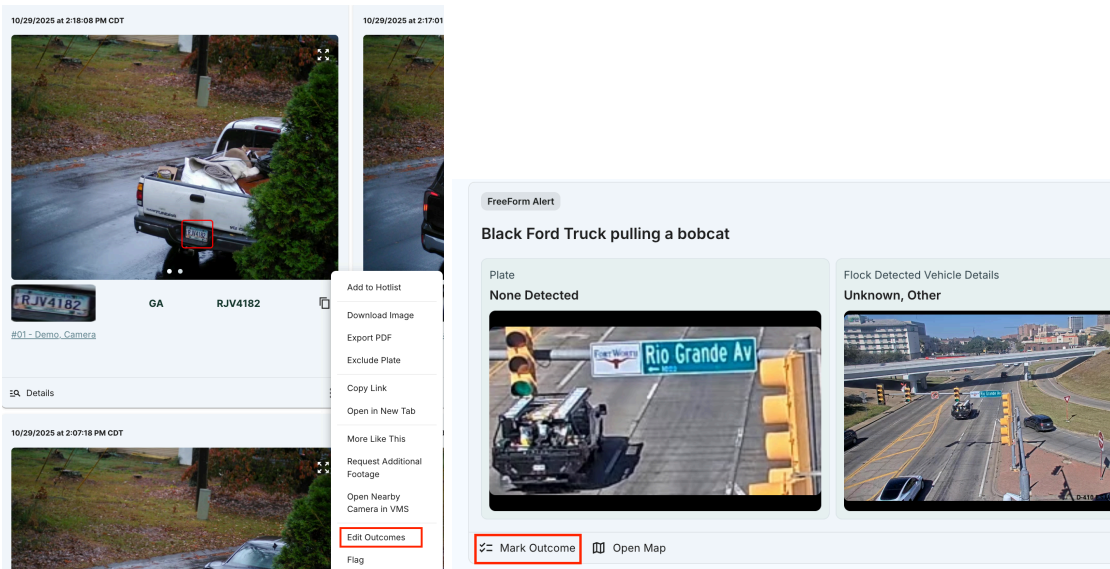
- Each user has the ability to log their activity without needing Administrative level permissions

Flock Outcome Capture - How To

Users can track actions made on a vehicle directly from an image card in their search results or hotlist alert.

1. To submit notes related to actions taken on a vehicle, select the three dots from your search results or vehicle details section or the 'Mark Outcome' icon on a Hotlist alert.



2. The entering user can use the text boxes to provide as many details related to their actions as possible, including the case number, crimes committed, and disposition.

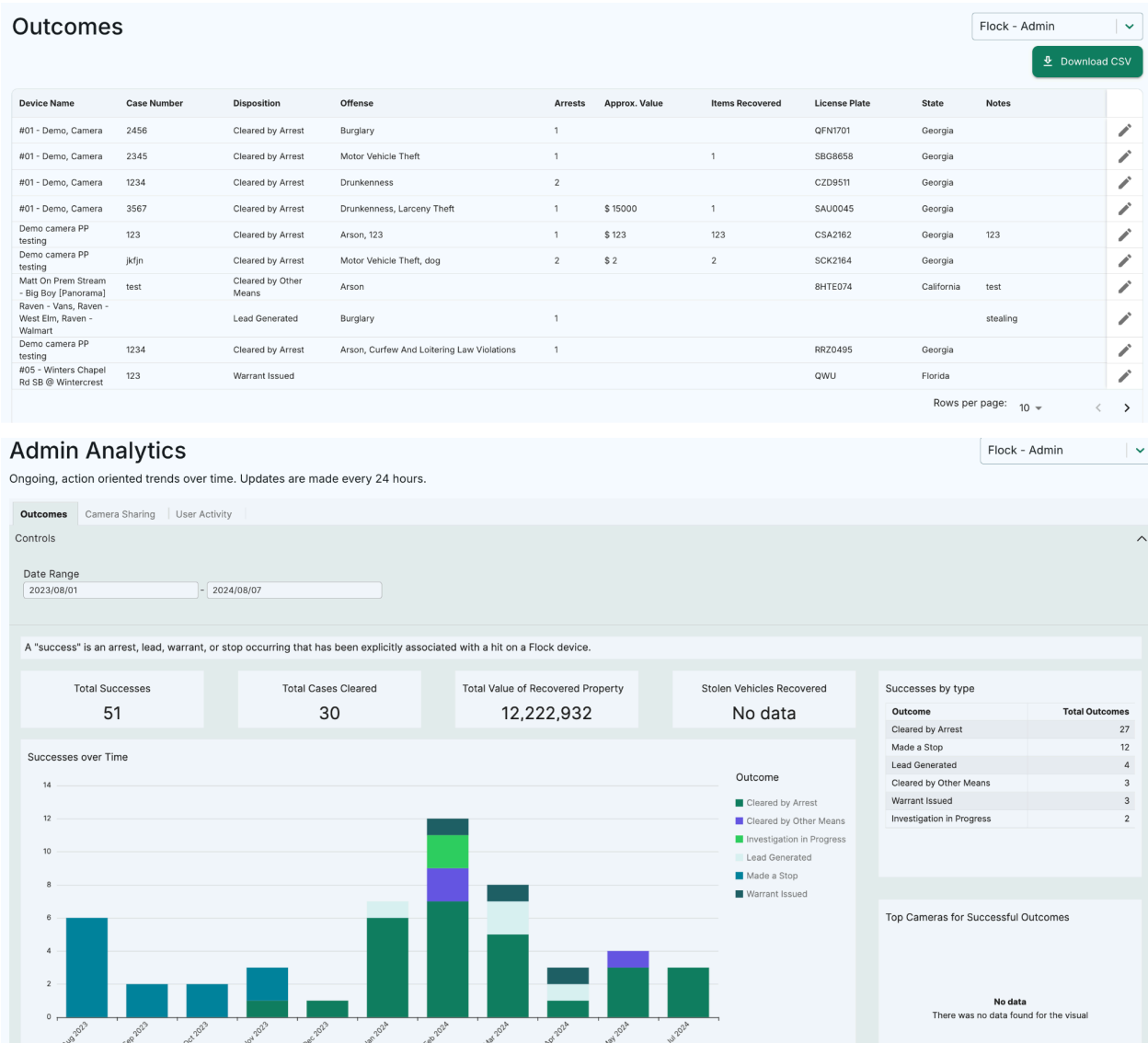
